 - A. Review progress on school wide goals

1. Pursue the highest levels of academic performance with primary focus on math.

- a. As part of tracking academic excellence, focus specifically on students who "approach" academic expectations with the goal that these students will grow to "met or exceeded" expectations.
- Alissa presented DIBELS reading skills inventory results from this school year (beginning of year to end of year). End of year data showed numbers of TCKS students measuring "significantly at risk" generally decreased through the school year and the pattern of improvement from Kindergarten to 3rd grade with this population in this skill at our school has been consistent over the years.

2.We will focus on increasing the number of students who feel a connection with staff members as measured by the Connectivity Survey from PSD

- a. Adding connectivity to staff in the building
- b. Staff will be encouraged to participate in social events such as the Read-In
- c. MTSS-B Chairs will visit every classroom to remind students and teachers of our universal expectations in the classroom, hallways, and lunchroom

Foreign Language - Tracy Williams – Tracy will return as FL chair. Integration of Duolingo (online app) is coming along. French may be offered next year too. Will send out survey to all students re: interest in French.

Mentor – Dawn Walsh – Colleen will take over as chair. Kindergarten will have a separate orientation/training program vs. during Back to School Night. Kindergarten teachers will meet with each family individually to help orient new parents. Survey showed parents liked the mentor program in general, but turnout was low for many of the mini-conferences with staff.

Shelly Falk – Science Fair – Learning Expo went great and we'll continue as planned. Our students did very well at the PSD Science Fair.

Wellness/Track – Chris Hunt – Streamlining Traut Track Ten and will have it at lunch time vs. Friday p.m.

Grants – Chris Hunt – Streamlining Grants committee on "as needed" basis other than PSD internal or recommended grants.
