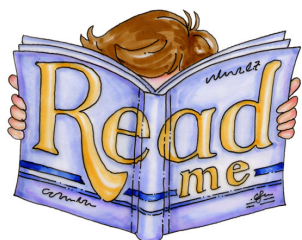

Narrative Writing Program
 This is a continuation of the writing program and skills learned in previous grades.
 Writing skills to include:

- Narrative, expository, descriptive, and persuasive writing, summaries, letters, research essays, poems
- Synthesize material from several sources, prepare a bibliography

Sayings and Phrases

Grammar

Skills to include:

- Subject/predicate; complete sentence
- Identify fragment and run-on sentences
- Subject/verb; identification and agreement
- Identify/use 8 parts of speech
- Direct/indirect objects
- Colon before a list and commas with appositive (in addition to punctuation skills learned in previous grades)
- Punctuation for books, movies, plays, magazines, stories, etc.

Spelling/Vocab.

Words to include:

- *Treasures* Spelling lists
- Sitton High Frequency Words list
- Curriculum Words
- Prefixes/suffixes (as described in CK sequence)



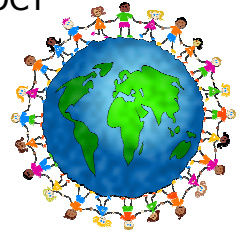
